### **About the role**

Board Members will have considerable experience, capabilities and connections within the public, voluntary or commercial sectors and the ability to understand strategic issues influencing the development of physical activity and sport.

Board Members will attend about six meetings each year plus additional time for preparatory work. Time commitments for committees, if applicable, would not exceed three meetings each year and each meeting typically runs to about two hours.

Board Members are appointed for a period of up to two years. Appointments are renewable for 3 further fixed terms of up to two years.

The roles are voluntary and is therefore not accompanied by any financial remuneration, although reasonable claims for travel and other expenses will be reimbursed.
